Dr. Marley is a retired Physician: (M.D. degree, 1966, U. of Alabama), U.S. Army Battalion Surgeon, 1st Infantry Division, (1967-1970), Radiology Residency, Scott & White Hospital, Temple, Texas, (1970-1974), and Associate Professor of Radiology, U. of Oklahoma Medical School, Oklahoma City, (1974-1976). From 1976-2000, Dr. Marley was a Radiologist in private practice in Yakima, Washington.

Dr. Marley has been a student of trumpet and cornet for 52 years. He has studied with Mr. Herman Moll, Troy, Alabama, Mr. Dick Schactler, Principal Trumpet of the Yakima Symphony Orchestra, Yakima, Washington, and with Dr. Tom Gause, Professor of Trumpet, Central Washington University, Ellensburg, Washington.
