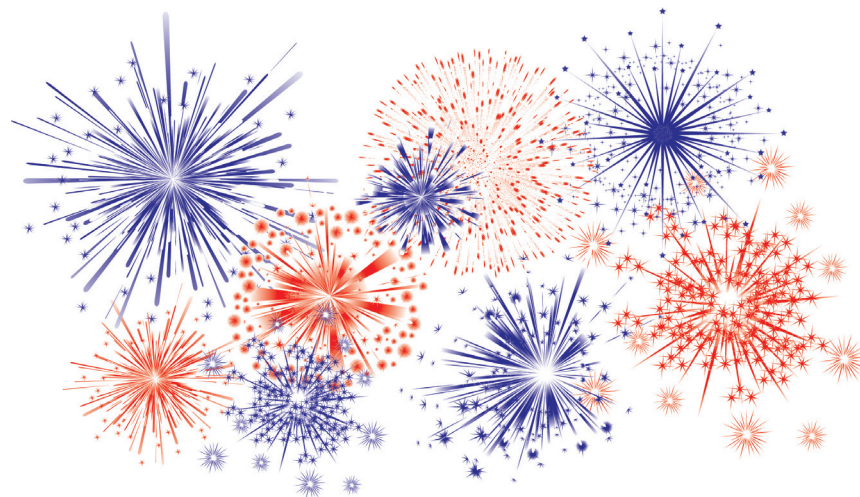

Founded in 1976 for the purposes of preserving the rich cultural heritage of the American concert band, this non-profit organization gives free concerts throughout the year in Athens, Georgia and surrounding communities. The band's repertoire includes all types of music: marches, jazz, pop, show tunes, excerpts from operas and musicals, as well as traditional and classical selections.

On September 7, 2006, Athens Mayor Heidi Davison and the Athens-Clarke County Commission issued a proclamation declaring the Classic City Band "the official municipal band of Athens, Georgia."
